Lady Argonauts Strengthen Softball Roster with All-Stars

Great Falls, MT –University of Great Falls head women’s softball coach Gary Ehnes is proud to announce the addition of two new Lady Argos; Charles M. Russell High School standout shortstop Alex Lowry and Nicole Boteilho, a 5’7”, right-handed outfielder from West Jordan, UT.

Lowry was recognized as an academic All-State athlete in 2008, 2009, and 2010. As a two sport athlete, Lowry earned recognition in softball and basketball for the Rustlers. In 2010 she was named to the first team All-State Softball Team and was also named to the prestigious Super State Team.

“I chose UGF because they have a great softball program as well as a great coaching staff. Playing for my home town was very attractive to me,” noted Lowry. She will team up with two additional Great Falls natives on the 2011-2012 Argonaut Softball team, Nicole Banach and Chea Hollis. Lowry will major in Health and Human Performance.

Boteilho was recognized as an honor student at Copper Hills High School. She served as the captain of her softball team and was a three-time Triple Crown All-American.
