

## Argonauts Crush the Vikings

**GREAT FALLS, Mont.** – The University of Great Falls Men’s Basketball Team improved its record to a perfect 7-0 by beating the University of Alberta at Augustana Vikings 90-50.

The Argos were led by 5-8 Huntley, Montana Freshman T.J. Harris who was 2 for 2 from beyond the arc and 5 for 8 from the field in 17 minutes of play. Marcel Towns lead the Argonauts with 12 rebounds. As a team the Argos shot 49.3% from the field, 33.3% from 3-point land, and 61.1% from the charity stripe.

Tenacity was a key word tonight as the Argos scored 23 points from second chance shots and 24 off of turnovers.

For the Vikings, who are now 3-8, Taylor Foreman scored 10 points and tied with David Shantz for the team lead in rebounds with 4. The comfortable lead allowed the Argos to play their entire bench and all but 2 scored.

“I am happy with the way we spread the ball around.” Coach Steve Silsby said. “Getting ahead early allowed us to try some different plays.” Silsby added, referring to a couple of “Alley-Oop” plays the Argos attempted. “We tried to get everyone on the team to score but fell just short of that goal.” Silsby said. The non-starters certainly made their presence know, outscoring the entire Viking team by 5 points.

The Argonauts have a week off before they take host the Blue Hawks of Dickinson State University on December 9<sup>th</sup> in the McLaughlin Center. The last meeting between the Argos and Blue Hawks on November 4<sup>th</sup> at Dickinson, was won by the Argos 83-72. “We know they (Dickinson State) are going to come in here better than the last time we saw them and looking for some revenge.” Silsby concluded.
