

**Great Falls, MT** – Senior Zach Johnson saved 5 shots on goal and Juan Guzman and Miguel Mendez each found the back of the Griffin's net as the University of Great Falls Argonauts shutout the Westminster College Griffins 2-0 in conference play at Seibel Park.

"I am very proud of the way our guys played today coming off of a tough loss to Jamestown." Head Coach Paul Zazenski said. "Westminster is a good side and we knew we would have to play a full game in order to win."

The Argo defense was all present and accounted for and stepped up to the task of keeping the Griffins from getting too close to the goal. "I thought that our defense stepped up today and set the tone from the start. It was ugly at times in the second half, but we fought through it and came out with a huge win today!" Zazenski added.

Guzman scored the first goal of the game with a header of a Manuel Espinoza assist at 27:45 in the first half. In the second half, Miguel Mendez drove the ball past Griffins Net Minder Dammar Sabanovic, off an assist from Pedro Chavez. Zach Johnson earned the shutout for the Argos.

The Argonauts improve to 12-3 overall and a conference leading 5-1, while the Griffins drop to 7-7-1 overall and 2-2-1 in conference. The Argos are on the road next Sunday to attempt to avenge their loss to Jamestown College. The Argos will close out their season with a November 2<sup>nd</sup> game against Rocky Mountain College. The game is scheduled to begin at 3:00 pm at Seibel Park. The Argos will be celebrating Senior / Parents day on November 2<sup>nd</sup>.
