

Coeur D'Alene, Idaho.- The University of Great Falls Wrestling Team competed in a double dual event today at North Idaho College. In the first dual the Argos grappled with and shut out Yakima Valley Community College 56-0.

The Argos were led by 125 lbs Patrick Neal who got the meet started off right by pinning his opponent, Jesse Ocamb. Next it was 133 lbs Scott Schlosser pinning his opponent Konner Hopkns. 141 lb Anthony Varnell matched his two predecessors by pinning his opponent Austyn Bronzi, as well as Ryan Martin at 149 lbs pinning his opponent Travis Addy.

The pin-fest came to a pause at 157 lbs as Michael Hader bear Ben Carter by a Major Decision. At 165 lbs Shawn Lau pinned Michael Ayala. 174 pounder Clark Hensley defeated his opponent Jose Martinez via a Major Decision. The Argos concluded the dual meet by winning the final 3 matched by pins as 184 lb Brock Picard pinned Daniel Agao, 197 lb Levi Morgan pinned Chris Burnett, and 285 lb Cole Amende pinned Rocky Carter to top off the shut out for the Argonauts.

In the late dual the Argonaut men beat Simon Frasier University 32-16. Earning victories for the Argos were Luis Carranza at 133 lbs, Robert Spackman at 141 lab, Mike Vassar at 149 lbs, Ryan Leonard at 157 lbs, Shawn Lau at 174 lbs, and Kamron Jackson who pinned his opponent Arjun Gill in 1:22. Carranza, Spackman, Lau and Jackson all won via pins.
