Brian Clarke recently completed his third season as the head women's soccer coach at the University of Great Falls. Prior to coming to UGF, Clarke headed the men's soccer program at his alma mater, the University of Mary (ND) for one season, helping the in a major rebuilding effort in the team's first season as a member of NCAA Division II.

The Newcastle, WY native competed for the Marauders from 2002-2005. In that time, Clarke was named team captain as a senior and was also selected as an NAIA All-American Scholar Athlete. He helped his team advance to the NAIA regional playoffs three times in four years. Clarke holds a USSF National Youth license as well as a NSCAA National Diploma.

Since coming to UGF, Clarke helped the Lady Argos to their first appearance in postseason play in school history in 2008 and followed that up with a second straight postseason appearance in 2009. He has mentored three All-Conference players and nine NAIA Scholar-Athletes.
