Price Takes Sixth at NAIA Outdoor Track & Field Championships

Marion, Ind. – University of Great Falls mid-distance runner Travis Price ended his sophomore season yesterday with a sixth place finish in the 800 meter run at the 2011 NAIA Outdoor Track and Field National Championships. The sophomore crossed in a time of 1:51.39 which earned him All-American honors.

Price, a Seward, Alaska native, had qualified for the 800 finals after running in the prelims on Thursday and semi-finals on Friday. Price, who earned All-American status at the NAIA Indoor Track and Field Championships in March, becomes UGF's most decorated track and field athlete in the program's short history.

Oklahoma Christian junior Silas Kisorio ran 1:49.56 in the 800 meter finals to take the top finish.

Four other athletes competed for Great Falls in the 4x800 meter relay on Thursday. The all sophomore team of Austin Stuchell, Jimmy Sliwa, Ander Jayo, and Andrew Hornung ran a time of 7:55.82 but failed to advance to the finals. Wayland Baptist won the event in 7:33.37.

Fellow Great Falls sophomore Christina Bruce competed in the women's marathon on Saturday and finished in 3:27:41.20. Bruce's time placed her 40th among the 60 runners who qualified for the event. Grand View's Obsie Birru won with a NAIA national record time of 2:4:40.01.
