### **Price Qualifies for Nationals at WAR 4**

**Spokane, Wash.** – The University of Great Falls track & field team travelled to the state of Washington this past weekend to compete against a tough field comprised of NCAA Division I, II, and III schools as well as NAIA. The WAR 4 meet host, Spokane Community College, was the only junior college competing.

Argo sophomore Travis Price qualified for the 2011 NAIA Outdoor Track & Field National Championships in the 800 meter run with a time of 1:52.57. The Seward, Alaska native, who also ran at the 2011 NAIA Indoor Track & Field National Championships in the 800, finished third out of 57 runners and set a new school record with his time.

Six other school marks were rewritten on Saturday including the 5000 meter run as freshman Taylor Guske ran a time of 15:24.50, finishing eighth overall. Fellow freshman Mickey Dayton had a throw of 37.54 meters in the discus for the school record.

The Lady Argo sprint relay team of senior Petey Davis, juniors Whitney Kossman and Danielle Keating, and sophomore Nychele Carley better their previous records in the 4x100 and 4x400 meter relays. The squad dropped 3 seconds off of their 4x400 record, running a time of 4:16.03 and ran 50.82 for the new 4x100 meter record. Keating also better her 400 meter run record crossing the line in 1:02.26.

Sophomore Shawna Schooley placed 13<sup>th</sup> in the 1500 meter run and set the school record with a time of 4:49.67.

The Great Falls track & field team will compete in the University of Montana Open this Saturday in Missoula.
