Argos Use Overtime to Capture Win

Salt Lake City, UT – Late into the second overtime, it looked like the University of Great Falls men's soccer team was on their way to a second draw in as many days. Yet, the Argos refused to roll over and netted a goal in the second extra time period to lock up a victory against the Northwestern College Red Raiders.

The Argo men again saw a nil-nil game going into halftime but early into the second half the tie was erased when **Miguel Mendez (Bonner's Ferry, ID)** struck a ball and watched it kiss off the crossbar and enter into the goal. The goal was the first of the season for Mendez.

The Argo defense, led by **Jesus Mendez (Bonner's Ferry, ID)**, **Jimmy Sliwa (Wasilla, AK)** and **Marius Theodorsen (Dramman, Norway)**, nearly held the Red Raiders to a shutout. However, Northwestern's **Justin Lehman (Orange City, IA)** punched in a goal from six yards out in the 86th minute, spoiling the Argo's shutout and eventually sending the match into overtime.

For his second time in two days, **Ryan O'Neil (Arima, Trinidad/James Madison University)** put the ball into the back of the net, this time a game-winner knocked in from eight yards out. Miguel Mendez was awarded the assist on O'Neil's goal. The Argos held the edge on shots by recording 13 in comparison to the Red Raider's 11.

The Argos (3-1-1) have Sunday off before they travel to Caldwell, ID to take on College of Idaho on Monday at noon. The Argos remain undefeated on the road trip with one win and a tie.
