Men's Soccer Finds Redemption As Women Drop Close One

Great Falls, MT – The University of Great Falls men's soccer team was looking for redemption today when they took on Rocky Mountain College after the Bears handed the Argos a 3-1 loss which was only their second of the season. The game was tied up at ones at the break before the Argos offense open things up in the second half eventually winning 4-1. The women faced the same Frontier Conference foe for the first time but dropped a tight match 2-1.

Sophomore **Miguel Mendez (Bonners Ferry, ID)** put the Argos up first when he sent a long ball sailing over the outstretched hands of Bears goalkeeper Joachim Soderstrom. Mike Eggen would knot the game up right before half when he headed in a corner kick from James Voisey. The stingy Argo defense, which only allowed the one shot on goal, would not allow another goal the rest of the game.

It was 17 minutes into the second half when junior forward **David Jimenez (Long Beach, CA)** would notch the game winner at the 57 minute mark to secure the win for the Argos. Juniors **Ryan O'Neil (Arima, Trinidad)** and **Pedro Chavez (Long Beach, CA)** would each add an insurance goal in the 62nd and 70th minute. The very physical match found each team receiving four yellow cards apiece while combining for a total of 30 fouls. Great Falls outshot Rocky Mountain 12 -8.

In the women's game, the Argos jumped on the board first with an **Ashley Pezel (Simi Valley, CA)** goal in the 17th minute of play. Sophomore **Mayra Castillo (Santa Ana, CA)** was credited with the assist. Great Falls would carry the lead into halftime before eventually falling to the Bears on two second half goals by Lauren Brophy. Freshman goalkeeper **Megan Walburn (Maple Valley, WA)** recorded nine saves for the Argos.

The Argo women are scheduled to host Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University (AZ) next Sunday, October 10 at Siebel Soccer Park. Kickoff is set for 2 pm. The men are idle next week and then will travel to Southern California to take on Marymount College and SOKA University on October 14 and 15.
