UGF Men's Soccer Wins First Round Game

Omaha, NE – It took two overtimes for the University of Great Falls men's soccer team to beat Montana foe Rocky Mountain College in first round action of the Unaffiliated Men's Soccer Independent Tournament. Junior forward Ryan O'Neil captured the game winning goal with only a minute remaining in the final sudden death overtime period.

O'Neil headed home the game winner in the 109th minute off of a William Obregon pass that was placed to the back post from 30 yards out. Great Falls goalkeeper Zach Johnson had four saves in the effort.

"I was really proud of the guys and their effort today," said an excited Head Coach Paul Zazenski. "It was a tough game and the boys really played hard. We know that we have another tough one ahead of us tomorrow and we are excited about the opportunity to advance to Nationals with a win."

Great Falls is set to take on the top seed and tournament host, Bellevue University, in the Championship game at 5 pm central standard time. Bellevue beat Westminster College of Salt Lake City in their first round game by a score of 2-1. The winner of the game will advance to the first round of the NAIA National Tournament.
