Argos Come Up Short

Billings, MT – The University of Great Falls Men’s Soccer team took to action this afternoon against the Rocky Mountain College Battlin’ Bears. The Argos would not show well defensively and the Bears would take advantage quickly in route to a 3-1 win over the visitors.

The Argos got off to a rough start allowing a goal in the opening minutes play. Oliver Gore was credited with the goal off of a James Voisey assist. The Bears would find the net again 17 minutes later when Gore struck for the second time on the day. This time it was Chris Jermy assisting Gore.

“We came out really flat in the first half,” said **Head Coach Paul Zazenski**. “A team can’t dig a hole like that early on and expect to beat a good team. I will give Rocky a lot of credit as they are much improved from last year.”

The Argos would be the first to get a goal in the second half as junior **David Jimenez (Long Beach, CA)** found the feet of junior **Pedro Chavez (Long Beach, CA)** who dribbled the goalkeeper and slotted the ball home. Chavez’s 86th minute goal would be his second on the season. Rocky Mountain would respond only two minutes later when Nick Heffernan took a pass from Jermy and put away the third goal for Bears.

Great Falls had eight corner kicks but could not produce any goals off of the many attempts. Rocky Mountain held an 8-9 shots on goal advantage and Argo goalkeeper **Zach Johnson (Casper, WY)** recorded five saves.

The Argos will be in action again this Saturday when they travel to Salt Lake City, UT to take on their conference rival the Westminster Griffins at 1:30 pm.
