Men's Soccer Downs Westminster on Senior Day

Great Falls, MT – The University of Great Falls men's soccer team finished their home schedule with a win over Westminster College today at Siebel Soccer Park. The Argos scored two first half goals and closed the day with a 2-0 victory.

"We came out a little flat, but once we found our rhythm I felt that we controlled the game," said **Head Coach Paul Zazenski**. "The guys worked hard today and it was a great win for our team and the seniors."

The Argos would get on the board first when junior **Alex Martinez (Long Beach, CA)** played a ball into the box which found the feet of **David Jimenez (Long Beach, CA)** who turned on goal and sent the ball to the back of the net. The goal was Jimenez's seventh of the season. Great Falls' senior **William Obregon (Managua, Nicaragua)** drove home a penalty kick 15 minutes later after Westminster was whistled for a hand ball in the penalty box to put the Argos up 2-0.

The Argos controlled the tempo throughout most of the game and allowed only four shots on goal. It was the third shutout this season for junior goalkeeper **Zach Johnson (Casper, WY)**. The win moves the Argos record to 12-2-1 with two games remaining.

The men travel to North Dakota next weekend to take on Jamestown College on October 30 at 2 pm. The next day, October 31, Great Falls will play the University of Mary in Bismarck at 3 pm.
