Frontier Conference Announces 2010-2011 All-Conference Men's Basketball Team

Whitefish, Mont. - Frontier Conference commissioner Kent Paulson announced the 2010-2011 all-conference men's basketball team, as well as individual award winners today. Brandon Brown of Montana Western was named the Player of the Year. Byago Diouf of Carroll College was named Defensive Player of the Year. Jake Orchard of Westminster College was named Newcomer of the Year and **Marcel Towns of the University of Great Falls** was selected Freshman of the Year. Coach of the Year honors went to second year coach Brandon Veltri of Carroll College.

Three University of Great Falls student-athletes received honors with Mark Celaya being named first-team and LJ Jones and Marcel Towns selected to the second-team. Celaya led the Argos in scoring with 16.4 points per game and shot 44 percent in conference play. Jones was the third leading rebounder in the Frontier with 6.3 boards a game and averaged 11.3 points. Towns shot 43.8 percent from the field throughout the season, scoring 9.6 points per game and had 39 steals in his freshman campaign for Great Falls.

"I am really happy for these guys," stated head coach Steve Silsby. "It is nice to see their hard work pay off. It is a great way for Mark to end his career and I am glad to have two of the three honorees (Jones and Towns) back next season."
