### **Celaya Leads Argos Over Tech**

**Great Falls, Mont.** – The Argos came out firing on all cylinders and knocked down 68 percent of their fields goals to take a commanding 39-20 lead into intermission. Great Falls never looked back from there and went on to defeat Montana Tech by a final of 74-64 behind a 29 point performance from senior Mark Celaya.

“We came out and took it to them (Tech) in the first half,” said head coach Steve Silsby. “When they went to zone in the second, we struggled a bit but pulled together and got the win. Mark and Marcel (Towns) had a great game and we played well defensively.”

A true freshman, Towns added 19 to Celaya’s 29 to lead the Argos. He also had three steals on the night. Celaya made 10 of his 18 field goal attempts (55 percent) and went 5-for-5 from the line. Junior Melvin Williams had a game-high six assists and dropped in nine points of his own.

Great Falls had one of their best shooting nights of the season connecting on 54.5 percent of their field goals. The Argos were 19-of-23 (82.6 percent) from the line which all came in the second half.

The win moves the Argos to 10-14 overall and 3-6 in league play. They will host No. 19 University of Montana Western tomorrow at 7:30 pm in the McLaughlin Center.
