Argos Shoot Lights Out to 71-54 Win Over Bears

Great Falls, Mont. – With two explosive dunks, one in each half, LJ Jones lifted the University of Great Falls men's basketball team to a 71-54 win over Rocky Mountain College. The 6'6" junior led the Argos with 19 points, making 9-of-14 from the field while pulling down four rebounds.

Great Falls controlled the entire first half, taking a commanding 13 point lead (40-27) into the break. The Argos, who have struggled shooting through the last three games, knocked down almost 52 percent of their attempts from the field. Great Falls also shot 84.6 percent from the line (11-for-13).

"The guys played hard tonight. We shot the ball well and did a great job defensively," said head coach Steve Silsby.

Junior college transfer Melvin Williams dropped in 15 while recording two rebounds, steals, blocks, and assists. Seniors and Chandler, Arizona natives Mark Celaya and Lukas Hamsch combined for 21 points. Hamsch led the team in assists with four. The other Chandler, Arizona senior, Dyston Madsen had a game-high 12 boards.

Rocky Mountain's Anthony Carter led the Bears with 10 points.

Great Falls (8-11, 1-3) will have little time to soak in the win before they play host to the nation's 16th ranked team in Carroll College (12-5, 2-2) tomorrow night at 7:30 pm.
