Argos Stop Rocky Mountain in Overtime

Billings, Mont. – In their second overtime game in three contests, the University of Great Falls men's basketball team secured the conference sweep of Rocky Mountain College with an 83-77 win over the Bears. Trailing, 37-33 at half, senior guard Lukas Hamsch hit a three-pointer with a second left in regulation to send the game into overtime tied at 72 apiece.

The Argos sunk 5-of-8 free throws and knocked down two three-pointers in overtime to secure the victory.

Senior Mark Celaya again led the Argos, who move to 11-16 overall and 4-8 in conference, with 32 points while grabbing four rebounds. Freshman guard Marcel Towns had a career-high 22 points. Melvin Williams added 11 points with nine rebounds, four assists and three steals.

Great Falls shot 56.5 percent from beyond the arc (13-of-23) for the game, nine of which came in the second half and overtime. The Argos forced Rocky Mountain to turn over the ball 18 times while only doing so 13 times.

Great Falls will host Lewis-Clark State College on Friday for the second to last conference game of the regular season. Tip-off is set for 7:30 pm.
