Lady Argos Drop Consecutive Heartbreakers

Santa Cruz, CA – The University of Great Falls softball team was in action today, dropping back-to-back heartbreaking decisions to the host Bethany Bruins, falling 8-7 in nine innings in game one of the doubleheader before dropping a 2-1 score in eight innings in the day's finale. The losses come one day after the Lady Argos were washed out of two games at Holy Names University due to rain and drops their overall record to 14-9 on the season.

"Those were two heartbreakers for sure," said UGF head coach **Gary Ehnes**. "We were right there with them in both games but we just couldn't get it done in the extra innings."

In game one, the Lady Argos pounded out 14 hits in the contest, most of which led them to establish a 7-3 lead going into the bottom half of the seventh inning. Bethany rallied and scored four times in the inning, knotting the score at 7-7 and forcing the extra innings, before tallying the game-winner in the home-half of the ninth.

Brittanie Thibodeaux (Lake Stevens, WA) and **Jenna Rosenberg (Othello, WA)** led the Lady Argo offense, each going 4-for-5 at the plate. Thibodeaux added two runs scored while Rosenberg also scored twice while driving in four runs and her effort included her second home run of the season. Centerfielder **Sarah DeVore (Hardin, MT)** went 3-for-5 with two RBIs of her own.

Ashley Densmore (Vancouver, WA) pitched seven and two-thirds innings, allowing eight hits while walking eight and striking out two, before she was relieved by **Alyse Sifuentes (Patterson, CA)** who was the hard-luck loser in the pitcher's circle.

Game two was a low-scoring pitcher's duel as UGF started **Casey Olson (Spokane, WA)** who held the Bruins to just one run over five and two-thirds innings. Bethany knotted the score at 1-1 in the home-half of the sixth and again pushed across the game-winner in the bottom of the eighth.

Neither team could muster much offense as they each totaled six hits. Rosenberg was the lone Lady Argo with a multi-hit game as she went 2-for-4, including her second homer of the day and her third of the season, accounting for the Lady Argos' single run of the contest.

UGF closes out their road trip with a doubleheader scheduled for 12pm and 2pm against NCAA Division I Idaho State on Monday. These games are make-ups from last Wednesday's rain out.
