### **Lady Argos Take Pair From Eastern Oregon**

**LaGrande, OR** - The University of Great Falls softball team improved to 14-7 on the season today, sweeping their doubleheader against Eastern Oregon University at Peggy Anderson Softball Field. The Lady Argos took the opener 4-3 via a seventh-inning rally and followed that up with a 9-4 win in the finale.

"We got two more quality wins today," said UGF head coach **Gary Ehnes**. "We rallied to win the first game in the seventh which we've done a few times already this year. That's always fun for the girls. It's a little nerve-racking for me sometimes but it shows our character. We're not going to fold when we're down."

After jumping out to a 2-0 lead in the opener on run-scoring knocks from **Anna Owen (Toledo, WA)** and **Sarah DeVore (Hardin, MT)**, the Lady Argos found themselves down 3-2 heading into the top of the seventh. **Emily Graham (Calgary, AB)** was then plated on a groundout by **Micaela Kurth (Boise, ID)** which set the stage for some heroics from **Brittanie Thibodeaux (Lake Stevens, WA)**. Thibodeaux singled up the middle to score **Jenn Andrews (Spokane, WA)** for the go-ahead tally.

**Ashley Densmore (Vancouver, WA)** then shut down the Mountaineers in the home half of the seventh as she picked up the win, going the distance in the circle, allowing two earned runs on five hits while striking out eight.

Game two saw the Lady Argos pound out five hits over the first two innings, establishing an early 6-0 lead in the process. The lead stood at 8-0 after the visiting half of the fifth. A bases clearing double from the Mountaineers' **Iris Woodhead** in the bottom of the inning saved EOU from the eight-run mercy rule.

Thibodeaux stayed hot going 2-for-3 at the plate with three RBIs while Owen contributed four hits in her four at-bats with two runs knocked in. The duo of Thibodeaux and Owen, the team's third and fourth batters in their lineup, also combined to score three runs.

Andrews recorded a multi-hit game as well, going 2-for-4 with a run scored.

"Owen and 'Tibbs' (Thibodeaux) are two very talented hitters. I really like their approach right now," Ehnes said. "And what more can you say about Jenn Andrews? She's done a nice job so far, especially considering she's making the transition back to softball after competing for coach (Arunas) Duda and the UGF volleyball team exclusively for two years."

**Casey Olson (Spokane, WA)** picked up the win in the circle. She went three innings and allowed three hits but didn't surrender a run. **Lindsay Cline (Helena, MT)**, yesterday's winner in the Lady Argos' defeat of the College of Idaho Coyotes, closed out the final four innings in the circle for UGF.

On deck for the Lady Argos is a trip this Wednesday, March 31, to face NCAA Division I Idaho State in doubleheader action.
