UGF Softball Wins 3, Drops 4 In Opening Days Of Season

Tucson, AZ – The University of Great Falls softball team officially got their season underway this past Friday competing in the 2010 Tucson Invitational held at Lincoln Park. Over the first three days of their season thus far, the Lady Argos are sporting a 3-4 record with two wins over Trinity International (15-7 on Friday, 7-3 on Saturday) and one against Hope International (11-0 today). The team will play a total of 19 games during their stay in southeastern Arizona.

“We got out of the gates fast on Friday with a good win over Trinity International,” said fourth-year head coach **Gary Ehnes**. “We let a couple winnable games get away from us but it’s still early and the girls are still getting used to playing with one another. I’m excited to see what we can do as we keep getting more and more games under our belt.”

Today, in addition to the win over Hope, the Lady Argos dropped a 5-3 decision to Aquinas College (MI) as well as an 11-3 loss to Bellevue University (NE), the latter of which was played in a sloppy rain storm with conditions near unplayable.

In the win over Hope, junior left-fielder **Anna Owen (Toledo, WA)** led the Lady Argos’ offensive attack, going 4-for-5 from the plate with two RBIs and three runs scored. First baseman **Jenna Rosenberg (Othello, WA)** added three RBIs of her own as she collected two hits in three at-bats.

Second baseman **Micaela Kurth (Boise, ID)** and shortstop **Brittanie Thibodeaux (Lake Stevens, WA)** each went 2-for-4 as the Lady Argos pounded out 15 hits in 35 at-bats. Kurth added three runs scored and an RBI while Thibodeaux knocked in a pair.

In the circle, junior **Ashley Densmore (Vancouver, WA)** and sophomore **Casey Olson (Spokane, WA)** combined on a one-hit shutout. Densmore started the game and surrendered the only Hope hit while striking out two and walking only one in five innings of work to pick up the win. Olson struck out two and walked one in her two innings of mop-up duty.

The Lady Argos are back in action tomorrow when they face Olivet Nazarene University (IL) at 10am followed by a 12:30pm game against Northwestern College (IA).
