Lady Argos Top Dawson Community College In Exhibition Doubleheader

Great Falls, MT – The University of Great Falls softball team opened their first and only home-stand of the 2010 season today by defeating the Dawson Community College Buccaneers by scores of 13-0 and 7-6 at the Great Falls Multi-Sports Complex. The games are designated as exhibition games and will not count on the team's overall record.

"We got off to a good start today in the opener," said UGF head coach **Gary Ehnes**. "We didn't get a ton of hits tonight but the balls we did hit were tagged. I saw some really good shots a number of different girls. We pitched pretty good for the most part and played some solid defense until some breakdowns in the seventh inning of the second game."

Shortstop **Jenn Andrews (Spokane, WA)** broke open the day's opener with a grand slam over the center field fence in what would become a seven-run fourth inning. Add that tally to the already-established 6-0 lead and all that was left was to secure three outs in the visiting half of the fifth to win by the eight-plus run mercy rule.

Outfielder **Anna Owen (Toledo, WA)** added a 2-for-2 performance with two extra-base hits, including a deep homer of her own to go with three RBIs and three runs scored.

Starting pitcher **Lindsay Cline (Helena, WA)** picked up the win in the circle as she pitched the first four innings before giving way to freshman **Alyse Sifuentes (Patterson, CA)** who came in for one inning of mop-up duty. Cline allowed two hits while walking only one and striking out five in her brief outing.

Game two saw a number of changes to the usual Lady Argo lineup but still showed a familiar result as they built a 7-2 lead before holding off a Buccaneer rally in the last. Three Lady Argo errors led to four runs for the visitors in the frame, before winning pitcher **Ashley Densmore (Vancouver, WA)** snared a come-backer line drive with the potential tying run on second base to end the threat. Densmore pitched five innings in relief of Sifuentes who was given the start, allowing six runs (just three earned runs) and six hits.

Sarah DeVore (Hardin, MT) led the Lady Argos at the plate as she went 2-for-3 with a run scored and four RBIs. Her three-run homer in the fourth proved to be the game-winner.

The Lady Argos are back in action against these same Buccaneers tomorrow afternoon in doubleheader action. First pitch in game one is set for 2pm.
