Lady Argos Take Black Hills State Three Games to One

Spearfish, S.D. – The University of Great Falls softball team improved their season record to 13-11 after travelling to take on the Yellowjackets of Black Hills State University on Saturday and Sunday. The Lady Argos swept the Jackets on day one, winning both games 6-3. The two teams would split on Sunday as Great Falls fell 4-8 in game one and then came back to win the second of the double-header, 13-5.

Kayla Souza pitched a complete-game victory to open things up for the Lady Argos on Saturday. She faced 28 batters, striking out four and allowing only six hits. Senior Lindsay Cline helped on the offensive side belting a three-run homer and finishing with four RBIs.

In the second game of the day, Alyse Sifuentes picked up her fifth win of the season in relief of junior Chloe Scudder. Kelli O'Brien sent one out in her one at-bat while driving in two runs. Freshman Brittney Robbins went 3-for-4 for the game.

On day two, the Lady Argos drove in three runs to begin the opening game but struggled in the next six, earning only one more. Dropping a 4-8 decision, Great Falls looked to end the weekend the same way they started.

Cline along with junior Kelsey Jirrels got the Great Falls' bats going in the second game as the squad grabbed eight runs in the first two innings. Cline, who also notched the victory on the hill, was 2-for-4 with four RBIs while Jirrels was 3-for-5, including a homerun and three RBIs. Cline pitched the complete-game with seven strikeouts and three base-on-balls, relinquishing only five runs.

The Lady Argos will be in action at home on Sunday, March 27 as they host Dickinson State University for a double-header. First game is set for 2:00 pm at the Multi-Sports Complex.
