Great Falls Softball Eliminated in Knock-Out Game

Rocklin, Calif. – In a tight game down to the wire the University of Great Falls softball team was eliminated from the Cal Pac/Frontier Qualifying Tournament by host William Jessup University 3-4 today. William Jessup advanced to the championship to face Simpson University.

William Jessup opened with a three-run homerun in the first inning to take an early lead. However, Great Falls scored one run and then saw Amanda Morris jack a two-run homer in the bottom of the third to tie the game at three apiece. After two scoreless innings, William Jessup managed to score one in the top of the sixth to take a 4-3 lead.

In the bottom of the seventh, the Lady Argos had the tying run on second and the winning run on first with two outs. WJU's pitcher Erin Houston would have the final say however, as she struck out Great Falls' final batter.

Junior Kelsey Jirrels led the Argo offense with two hits and senior Amanda Morris added a homerun and two RBIs. Sophomore pitcher Alyse Sifuentes struck out five in six innings.

The Lady Argos finish the season 16-15 and were two games shy of reaching the NAIA National Tournament.
