Lady Argos Split First Day of Tucson Play

Tucson, Ariz. – After starting the season out 3-3 against the College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon University, the University of Great Falls softball team travelled to Arizona to get 14 games in six days. Opening with Robert Morris University (Ill.) yesterday, the Lady Argos dropped their first game, 4-10. Bouncing back in the second game against Trinity International University, Great Falls rallied in the seventh inning with three runs to win 4-2.

Robert Morris earned their 10 runs on 13 hits, capturing 10 runs-batted-in (RBI). Great Falls also had 13 hits but only mustard four RBI's. Senior Amanda Morris hit a homerun for the Lady Argos making it her second of the season.

In the second game, Lady Argo Alyse Sifuentes picked up her third win of the year on the hill as she pitched two innings, allowing only one hit while facing seven batters. Senior Brittanie Thibodeaux managed two hits and two RBI's in two at-bats to lead the Argo offense. Helena native, Lindsay Cline closed the game for the Lady Argos allowing only two runs and three hits. Cline faced 18 batters in five innings.

The first day split keeps Great Falls at .500 with a record of 4-4. The team will face No. 15 Olivet Nazarene University this morning followed by Viterbo University and Jamestown College this afternoon.
