UGF Softball Leaves Arizona at .500

Tucson, Ariz. – The University of Great Falls softball team won their last four games at the Tucson Invitational to improve their record to 10-10 on the season. Starting out 3-7 in the first four days of the invite, the Lady Argos got the bats going and went 4-0 in the last two days.

On Sunday, Great Falls used four runs in the last inning to secure the 12-10 win over Mayville State University (N.D.). Sophomore Alyse Sifuentes knocked in six RBIs on three hits with two being sent out of the park. Brittanie Thibodeaux added three RBIs with three hits. Kayla Souza picked up the win pitching six innings with two strike-outs. Great Falls out-hit Mayville 14-11 but committed six errors.

In the second game, the Lady Argos shut out Mount Marty College (S.D.) notching a 10-0 victory. Centerfielder Anna Owens went 4-for-4 with a homerun and freshman Brittney Robins was also perfect going 3-for-3 with a homer and four RBIs. Junior pitcher Casey Olsen picked up her first win of the season going five innings and allowing only one hit.

Great Falls will travel next to Spearfish, S.D. for two double-headers against the Yellowjackets of Black Hills State University on Saturday, March 19 and Sunday, March 20. First game is set to start at 1 pm (MST) on Saturday and 12 pm (MST) on Sunday.
