### **Argos Fall To Rocky Mountain**

**Billings, MT**– The University of Great Falls volleyball team could not keep the momentum following the major Frontier Conference upset over 20<sup>th</sup> ranked Carroll College on Thursday and fell to Rocky Mountain College in three sets tonight. The loss drops Great Falls (6-13, 3-4) to fifth place in conference standings.

The Bears won the first set 25-13 while the Argos would make the next two sets closer contests before falling 25-23 in each. Junior outside hitter **Tosha Nunes (Fallon, NV)** led Great Falls with 12 kills and middle blocker **Taylor Lucero (Fresno, CA)** added 10 of her own. Freshman setter **Averi Pasma (Simms, MT)** and junior setter **Jessika Weber (Idaho Falls, ID)** each had 18 assists for the match. The Argo defense was again led by junior **Kali Schmidt (Whitefish, MT)** who finished the night with 11 digs.

“We knew this was going to be a tough match for us, especially after such an emotional win two days prior,” stated **Head Coach Arunas Duda**. “We got to see a lot of players in action tonight and I think the ladies realize that they have to keep pushing and work on being more consistent the second half of conference play.”

Great Falls is idle this week in regular season action but will play the annual alumni match on October 9 at the McLaughlin Center. The Argos will begin the second part of Frontier Conference play on October 15 when they host the University of Montana Western at 7 pm.
