### **Abramson Signs with UGF Women's Basketball**

**Great Falls, Mont.** – The University of Great Falls head women's basketball coach Bill Himmelberg announced today that Lindsey Abramson signed a Frontier Conference Letter of Intent with the Lady Argos. Abramson will join the UGF women's basketball program and enroll in classes beginning in the fall of 2011.

"We are excited that Lindsey has chosen to join our program," said Himmelberg. "She is a natural scorer and rebounder and will provide us with a really big presence inside (the paint). Lindsey is an excellent student and will be a great addition, not only to our team, but to the entire university."

Abramson, who was recently named Black Canyon Region Player of the Year, is a 6' 2" post from Cactus High School in Peoria, Ariz. During the past season, Abramson was a force for the Cobras and led them to the state semifinals. She averaged a double-double with 16.3 points and 11.4 rebounds a game throughout the 2010-2011 season. Abramson was a 2010 and 2011 Class 4A All-State player, 2010 and 2011 First Team All-West Valley Region honoree, and 2011 McDonalds All-American nominee.

"After my visit to the school and meeting the team and coaching staff, I am so excited about becoming a member of the Lady Argo basketball team and contributing to the team's success," commented Abramson.

Abramson will add some much needed size to the Great Falls squad who lost four seniors to graduation, three of which accounted for most of the program's height.
