Saints Trip Up Lady Argos

Great Falls, Mont. – Although four Lady Argos reached double-digits in the scoring column, Great Falls fell to the Saints of Carroll College, 68-83, on Saturday night. The Saints, which rank 25th in the latest NAIA polls, were coming off a tough loss to MSU-Northern on Friday. Great Falls lost only its second conference game in four to Rocky Mountain on the same day.

Carroll's Alysha Green led all scorers with 25 points. Lady Argo freshman Sarah Sciascia continued her impressive play coming off the bench to put up a team-high 21 points. Sciascia was 8-of-16 from the field and made one three-pointer on three attempts. She was perfect from the line (4-4).

Junior Kezia Ford had 13 points and senior Marissa Skogen added 11 points with seven rebounds. Redshirt freshman Chelsea Adams rounded out Great Falls' top point getters with 10.

Senior Jamie Young grabbed a game-high 10 rebounds and chipped in nine points.

Great Falls shot 33.8 percent from the field while Carroll made almost 44 percent of their shots. The Argos were 17-of-19 (89.5%) from the free throw line and forced 15 turnovers.

The Lady Argos hit the road next weekend as they travel to Salt Lake City on Thursday to take on the Griffins of Westminster College. The Lady Griffins are ranked 15th in the nation.
