Lady Argos Top MSU-Northern in Conference Opener

Great Falls, MT – Lady Argo Kezia Ford continued with her hot hand as she poured in 24 points to lead the Great Falls women’s basketball team to their first conference win of the season. The Argos led by seven at half and never looked back as they downed the Skylights, 85-73.

“This was a big win for us,” exclaimed first year head coach Bill Himmelberg. “The ladies played hard and shot the ball very well tonight.”

Great Falls made 58% of their field goals throughout the contest and shot 71% from the free throw line. The Lady Argos also saw 46% of their three point attempts drop.

Freshmen Sara Sciascia contributed 16 points off the bench while seniors Aline Lino and Marissa Skogen combined for 23. Grabbing eight rebounds apiece were Lino, Ford, and senior Jamie Young. Freshman guard Chelsea Adams dished out a game-high six assists.

Great Falls dominated the boards as they out-rebounded the Skylights, 42-25. The win moves the Lady Argos to 6-8 on the season and 1-0 in conference play.

“I am really proud of the team and how we executed tonight. We hope to carry this momentum into these last two non-conference games,” stated Himmelberg.

The Lady Argos only get one day of rest before hosting Walla Walla University on Sunday, January 9 at 6 pm. The two teams are slated to play again the following day. Tipoff for Monday’s game is set for 12 noon.
