Cold Shooting Troubles Lady Argos; Fall to Tech

Great Falls, Mont. – Unable to shake a cold shooting night, the University of Great Falls women's basketball team fell to Montana Tech 64-74 at the UGF McLaughlin Center tonight. Although the Lady Argos only made 18.4 percent of their field goals in the first, they went into the break only trailing by five points.

However, the Lady Diggers would not let Great Falls back into the game as they went on to put up 42 points in the second making 16-of-32 field goal attempts.

Freshman Sarah Sciascia again led the Lady Argos with 14 points and junior Kezia Ford added a double-double with 13 points and 12 rebounds. Freshman guard Chelsea Adams had a game-high four steals and dropped in 10 points.

Great Falls shot 86 percent from the free-throw line as they made 19-of-22. Tech ended the night with a 41.8 shooting percentage from the field and were led by freshman Kelsey DeWit who had 21.

The Lady Argos will host University of Montana Western tomorrow at 5:30 pm. Great Falls is looking for a sweep of Western as their last win was against the Bulldogs back in January.
