Lady Argos Win 69-65 Over Bears

Billings, Mont. – Lady Argos' Kezia Ford and Sarah Sciascia shot lights-out as each put up 18 points to lead the University of Great Falls women's basketball team to a 69-65 win over Rocky Mountain College. The effort marks the 10th victory of the season and third in league play for the Lady Argos who avenged their earlier loss to the Bears on January 21.

Ford was perfect from behind the arc (4-of-4) and ended with a 77.7 percent shooting percentage (7-of-9). Sciascia was also perfect but from the charity stripe (4-of-4). She was 6-of-8 shooting from the field (75 percent).

Sciascia, a freshman guard, had team-highs in assists and steals with four and three, respectively. Senior Jamie Young added 14 points to the effort.

Great Falls shot 46 percent from the field while holding the Bears to 33 percent. The Lady Argos knocked down 12-of-15 free throw attempts (80 percent).

The two teams split during conference action with each winning on the road.

Great Falls will conclude league play this coming weekend when nationally ranked Lewis-Clark State College and Westminster College come to town. Lady Argos will take on No. 11 L-C State on Friday night at 5:30 pm.
