### **Women's Basketball Drops Finale to Ninth-Ranked Griffins**

**Great Falls, Mont.** – Although the University of Great Falls women's basketball team outscored Westminster College 42-38 in the second half, it was not enough as the Lady Argos fell to the ninth-ranked Griffins, 79-75 at the McLaughlin Center.

All five Great Falls starters hit double figures with freshman Sarah Sciascia leading the Lady Argos with 21. Sciascia also grabbed seven rebounds and had six steals.

Freshman guard Chelsea Adams added 12 points and dished out three assists. Junior Kezia Ford and senior Jamie Young chipped in 11 apiece.

Senior forward Marissa Skogen tossed in 10 points which put her at 1,014 career points at UGF. Skogen surpassed the 1,000 point mark last night versus Lewis-Clark State College as she put up 10 points against the Warriors.

Great Falls finished the night shooting 35.8 percent from the field but was 75 percent from the free throw line making 15-of-20. Westminster made 58 percent of their shots throughout the game. The Lady Argos forced 21 turnovers while only committing 14.

Great Falls will head down to Salt Lake City, Utah on Tuesday, March 1 for a rematch with Griffins in the opening round of the Frontier Conference Tournament. Game time is set for 7 pm.
