Women's Hoops Record First Win; Fall to L-C State

Lewiston, ID- In their first game of the Warrior Invitational, the University of Great Falls women's basketball team picked up their first win of the season defeating Warner Pacific College, 62-58. The Argos had four players scoring in the double digits on Saturday.

Freshman guard Chelsea Adams (Lafayette, CO) led the Argos with 14 points and three steals. Great Falls natives, Jamie Young and Marissa Skogen, poured in 13 and 12 points respectively and each pulled down seven rebounds. Junior forward Kezia Ford (Augusta, MT) rounded out the Argos' top scorers with 11 points. Warner Pacific's Miranda Holenstein led all scorers with 18.

Great Falls shot an outstanding 94.4% (17-for-18) from the line while shooting 35.8% from the field. The Argos forced 24 turnovers and committed only 17 of their own in the win.

In the Argos second game of the invitational, the squad went up against an undefeated Lewis-Clark State team. The fifth ranked Warriors took an early 33-19 lead at half before going on to win, 71-45.

Great Falls got off to a great start and scored nine straight points for a 9-2 lead barely three minutes into the game. Over the next 37 minutes, however, the Argos managed only 36 points against the Warriors' pressure defense.

Tournament MVP Jasmine Stohr led all scorers with 19 points. Junior Kezia Ford was the Argos top scorer with nine points and brought down seven rebounds. Ford was also named to the all-tournament team along with teammate Marissa Skogen, who added eight points and eight boards for the Argos.

Great Falls takes on Walla Walla University on Monday night for their third game in as many days. Tip-off is set for 5 pm (PST).
