Rocky Proves Too Hot To Handle For Lady Argos

Billings, MT – The University of Great Falls women's basketball team dropped their sixth straight game on Thursday, falling to the Rocky Mountain College Lady Bears 73-48 at the Fortin Center in Frontier Conference action. The Lady Bears (6-13, 4-2) cruised to a 33-20 halftime lead and never looked back as the Lady Argos fall to 3-15, 0-6.

"Well it was the same recipe for us; we didn't shoot the ball well and we committed too many turnovers," said UGF head coach **Shawn Chaffin**, referring to his team's 25% shooting and 25 turnovers. "We are really strapped as far as our depth in concerned right now. We only have five players with a significant amount of experience."

The Lady Argos had no answer for 5'9" senior guard **Molly Schenderline (Lodge Grass, MT)** who torched the nets for 26 points on 10-of-16 shooting, including 4-of-5 from behind the three-point arc. Schenderline also contributed a game-high eight rebounds to lead the Lady Bears to their fourth league win, after only two victories in the pre-season portion of their schedule.

Fellow senior guard **Tana Stewart (Hardin, MT)** added 12 points and five assists to the Lady Bears' cause. Junior center **Adrienne Green (Reed Point, MT)** chipped in with 10 points and five rebounds. Reserve center **Laura Beach (Baker, MT)** hauled in seven rebounds in just 14 minutes of action to help the Lady Bears to a 46-36 rebounding edge.

The Lady Argos were led by junior forward **Katie Wright (Cedaredge, CO)** who came off the bench to score a season-high 12 points on 4-of-9 shooting from the field. Fellow junior **Kirilynn Winkler (Great Falls, MT)** notched 11 points and five rebounds. **Marissa Skogen (Great Falls, MT)** was her usual self, making her presence felt all over the court with 10 points, seven rebounds, five steals and two blocked shots.

The Lady Argos are back in action on Saturday in Helena as they look to crack the code on their first conference win of the season against rival Carroll College at 6pm.
