UGF Women's Basketball Inks Sheridan Star



Great Falls, MT – The University of Great Falls women's basketball coach **Shawn Chaffin** has announced that **Sydnee Burke**, a 5'6" combo guard from Sheridan, MT has signed a National Letter of Intent to attend UGF beginning in the fall 2010 semester.

Burke brings excellent basketball credentials to the Electric City as she averaged 17.5 points per game as a junior in 2008-2009, while averaging 3.4 made three-point baskets per contest to go with 4 rebounds, 3 assists and 4 steals per game as well. She was a Class C First-Team All-State Selection last season and was chosen to play in the Southwest Montana All-Star Classic held in Butte. Burke has also been an All-

Conference performer in volleyball and track during her scholastic career.

"Sydnee is an explosive scorer with tremendous range and touch from the three-point line," Chaffin said. "She also has a canny knack for getting into the paint and finishing. Sydnee is one of the top guards in state this year, and I am looking forward to her making a sizable contribution next season."

On her signing Burke commented, "I am excited to become an Argo and I am looking forward to a great future at UGF, both academically and athletically. I was very impressed with the coaching staff and the players. Coach Chaffin has made me feel more than welcome to become a part of his program."

She is the daughter of Steve and Shelly Burke and she will be majoring in science.
