UGF Women's Basketball Adds Roberts High Star

Great Falls, MT – University of Great Falls women's basketball coach **Shawn Chaffin** has announced the signing of 5'10" guard **Taylor Nelson** of Roberts, MT to a NAIA National Letter of Intent today. Roberts will enroll in classes at UGF in the fall of 2010 after completing her senior year at Roberts High School.

"Taylor is an athletic wing who has the ability to shoot a high percentage from the three-point line," Chaffin commented. "She possesses the length that we like our wings to have and she runs the floor very well. Taylor also has a knack for having some of her biggest games against top competition. She is a very heady player and we are excited that she will be joining us next season."

Nelson was an All-Conference performer in 2008-09 as she averaged 20.3 points, 9.1 rebounds, 4.7 assists and 2.5 steals per game. A very versatile player, Nelson also garnered All-Conference honors as a sophomore in 2007-08.

"I really like the religious aspect that the University of Great Falls offers," Nelson said. "My faith is something that's very important to me and I'm glad that can continue when I enroll here. Also, when I came on my visit, the players and coaches made me feel welcome from the moment I stepped foot on campus. I am very excited to be able to continue my education and my basketball career here at UGF."

Nelson plans to major in secondary education. She is the daughter of George and Stacey Nelson. Her father, George, is also her high school coach at Roberts High.
