

**UGF AND ROCKY MOUNTAIN PLAYERS NAMED
FRONTIER CONFERENCE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

WHITEFISH, Mont., Sept. 19, 2012– Danny Deladillo of the University of Great Falls (UGF) and Taylor Ita of Rocky Mountain College were named Frontier Conference men’s soccer players of the week.

Delgadillo, a 5-foot-6 freshman forward from Long Beach, Calif. was named offensive player of the week. UGF won two matches, beating Embry-Riddle (Ariz.) 1-0 and Westminster College 3-2. Delgadillo had two goals in the Westminster match including the game winning goal with two minutes left to play in overtime. Also nominated: Evan Connolly of Rocky Mountain College and Dennis Sellis of Westminster College.

Ita, a 5-foot-10 junior defender from Havre, Mont., was named defensive player of the week. Rocky won both of their weekend road matches, beating Mount Marty 8-0 and Dakota Wesleyan 1-0. Ita’s strong defensive play was key in the two wins. Also nominated: K.C. John of Westminster College.
