Argos Men's Soccer Beats Westminster in Overtime

Salt Lake City, UT – Argo Freshman soccer player Danny Delgadillo is having a memorable first year. With a bit more than 2 minutes left in overtime, against conference rival Westminster College, Delgadillo took a feed from senior Ryan O'Neil and found the back of the Griffins net for the game winner. The Argos beat the Griffins 3-2 to improve their conference record to 2-0 and 4-2 overall.

"I am extremely proud of their effort today" Argo Head Coach Paul Zazenski said. "To win on the road against a conference rival is huge." Zazenski added. "(Goal) Keeper Zach Johnson really played well today." Johnson played all 107:47 minutes of the game. Johnson saved 6 Griffin shots on goal while only allowing 2 goals.

Westminster's Sean Aslett scored the first goal of the game in the second period of play with a header off the assist of Wilson Larson. Danny Delgadillo scored for UGF 13 minutes later to tie the score. The Argos scored again 61 seconds later as senior Pedro Chavez drove the ball into the upper right corner of the net. The Griffins tied the score off of a penalty kick from Dennis Sellis 79:44 minutes into the game. The contest remained tied until Delgadillo scored the game winner 17:47 minutes into overtime.

The Argos are back in Salt Lake City, next week, on the 24th and 25th to take on Marymount College and Bellevue University, respectively.
