The Fichna Trust has established a full ride scholarship for students pursuing a career in health sciences at the University of Great Falls. The Scholarship covers tuition, fees, books, housing and meal plan, and is renewable for four years.

Deadline for submission: January 30, 2017.

Scholarship eligibility requirements:

- Academically competitive
- Accepted for admission to the University of Great Falls beginning Fall 2017 as a full time, campus undergraduate student.
- Must be majoring in Exercise Science, Biology, or Chemistry with the intent to pursue graduate education in a health sciences field.
- Demonstrate financial need as indicated by the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

To apply for the Fichna Trust Scholarship, please submit the following:

- This completed application form.
- Letter of recommendation from a high school counselor, principal or teacher.
- Resume of service and/or leadership demonstrating participation in school or service organizations, or individual efforts.
- An essay of at least 500 words on the following prompt:
 - Tell us about your dreams and plans for your health sciences career, what you've done so far to realize them, and how this scholarship would help you achieve your goals.

If selected as a University of Great Falls Scholar, the following expectations are required to maintain the scholarship:

Campus Involvement requirements

- Live on campus as a resident student of the University for all four years of the scholarship period.
- Documented involvement in at least 2 campus clubs or organizations, or in leadership roles such as Peer Mentor, Resident Advisor for campus housing, academic tutor, or other approved campus service experience.
- Participation in community service opportunities through Student Development, Campus Ministry and other University programs.

Academic requirements

- Maintain a 3.0 GPA each semester and a 3.0 GPA overall. Students whose GPAs fall below 3.0 cumulative GPA are placed on scholarship probation for one semester. Failure to maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA after that will result in the loss of the scholarship.
- University of Great Falls Scholars must be enrolled continuously as full time students (at least 12 credits per semester.)
- The University of Great Falls Scholar award is renewable each year for four years. University of Great Falls Scholar funds may not be used toward summer session tuition or for more than 18 credits per semester.
